

POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

SCHEDULE OF OPERATION

Season: The pool season begins the Saturday prior to Memorial Day and extends through Labor Day. The Jayhawk Club Management reserves the right to begin pool season earlier and extend the pool season later.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Weather and facilities permitting, the pool will be open from 11am to 8pm, Sunday-Wednesday and Thursday-Saturday from 11am to 9pm. From time to time, as determined by The Jayhawk Club Management, the pool may be closed to accommodate special functions, pool maintenance or other circumstances. ** The pool hours will be limited, as posted, when the school season starts up.

REGISTRATION AND GUESTS

Members and guests are required to check in at the pool entrance upon entering the pool area. Children under the age of fourteen (14) must be accompanied by a member or a person designated by member sixteen (16) years of age or older. Guests are limited to six (6) visits per season. Guest fees can be charged to your account and billed on your monthly statement.

AUTHORITY

A Pool Manager will be on duty at all times when the pool is open with exceptions as mentioned above in Schedule of Operation. The staff will have full control of the pool, deck, and facilities, and will use their authority in the best interest of the safety and enjoyment of the members and guests. The pool staff has absolute authority to refuse admittance to or remove from the pool and facilities anyone who violates the rules. Violations may result in suspension of pool privileges. Repeated violations may result in permanent forfeiture of pool privileges. The Pool Manager and staff do not make the rules, but they are responsible for enforcing them. Members having questions or concerns about the rules should direct their questions to the attentions of the Pool Manager or the General Manager.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Articles considered dangerous to the safety of persons using the pool may not be brought or worn into the pool area. Such articles include but are not limited to hair curlers, hairpins, styrofoam products, ice chests and coolers, other than those provided by the club. Glass containers and bottles are prohibited from the pool area.

DISEASE PREVENTION

Persons with a visible skin disorder, open wound, or any communicable disease will not be allowed in the pool.

ATTIRE

Persons using the pool must wear suitable swimming attire. Swimmers must be fully clothed before entering the clubhouse, golf course, or golf practice areas.

POOL PROPERTY

The improper use or abuse of pool furniture, fixtures, or equipment could result in an assessment for damages, forfeiture of pool use privileges, or both.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted inside the pool deck area.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Food and beverages are allowed only in designated areas. All food and beverages must be purchased from the club. No outside food items may be brought into the pool area. Violation will result in the member or guest being asked to remove the food, beverage and/or cooler from the premises. Repeated violation may result in loss of pool privileges.

POOL PARTIES

Arrangements for parties and groups must be made with the Food & Beverage Director at least 72 hours in advance, so that scheduling conflicts can be avoided and appropriate lifeguard and service staff can be assured.

DIAPER CHANGING

Changing tables are provided in the pool's restrooms. The changing of children's diapers or soiled clothing in the pool area including all portions of the pool deck is strictly prohibited. Violation will result in the member or guest being asked to leave the pool area immediately and properly dispose of soiled diapers or clothing in the restroom area. Repeated violations may result in loss of pool privileges.

POOL DECK

Use pool at your own risk when lifeguards are not on duty. Dive only in designated areas. Children not potty trained must wear swim diapers. There is no running or dangerous horseplay allowed at the pool.
